

Our Tucson Math Science Technology FunFest is a great educational opportunity for students. Here are a few tips to ensure good behavior.

Time management is important. Please be on time to all "workshops" as the doors close promptly. Workshops are a new format and the students will need to stay in the area the entire time. Please get drinks and go to the restroom before arriving to your workshop. The spaces are not in the exhibit area, please use the enclosed maps and time to locate those areas before you come to the TCC.



Expect the best. Please consider this opportunity to be an "extension of the classroom." Teachers are expected to prepare the children well, and students are to be on their best behavior.

Keep ratios small and safe. One adult for every 5-8 students seems to be about right. If someone becomes separated from the group, please tell them to locate the INFORMATION booth in the exhibit main room.

Coach the chaperones before arriving at the Funfest. Adults/parents who accompany a field trip need specific instructions and objectives for student behavior.

Security will be present. Unfortunately, groups of unsupervised children, dancing in the hallways, or making 911 calls on the public pay phones occurred last year. Please address these concerns before entering the TCC.

Eat together. Eating lunch together will promote good behavior and increase discussion about the math, science and technology. Please clean up.

Before dispersing groups-- plan a meeting spot for lunch and a specific time for departure, review behavior expectations, locate the Welcome Center and bathrooms.
